Eligibility

Anyone registering must be at least 16 years old. Lincoln Park High School students must have earned 10 credits prior to enrollment, must be credit deficient, cannot take a specific graduation requirement unless the course was previously failed, are limited to one course per quarter except those eligible for June graduation may select two courses during the fourth quarter and must have written permission from a counselor or administrator specifying course(s) to be taken. Non-resident students who are dually enrolled as day students from another district must have written permission from a counselor or administrator approving course selections.

Fees

Tuition is \$180 per course for Lincoln Park High School Day Students.
 Tuition is \$240 per course for Non-Lincoln Park Students and Non-Residents.
 All fees must be paid at time of registration. **Fees are not refundable.**
